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PERMIT, AMPLIFIER PERMIT, ALCOHOL IN PLASTIC CONTAINERS ON THE SIDEWALK, AND THE STREET CLOSURES OF MAIN STREET FROM RAILROAD STREET TO WEST STREET; SECOND STREET FROM MAIN STREET TO CRAWFORD STREET; NORTH STREET FROM RAILROAD STREET TO WEST STREET; AND FIRST STREET FROM MAIN STREET TO CRAWFORD STREET ON JULY 31, 2010, FROM NOON TO 10:00 P.M. WICKER, REICHERT, RUSSELL, FORSYTHE, ECKMAN, AND LIBERATORE VOTING AYE; MOTION CARRIED.

MR. AND MRS. NUDI HAVE REQUESTED A FENCE VARIANCE AT 200 W. LINCOLN. THE PROPERTY IS A CORNER LOT, AND THE VARIANCE INCLUDES EXTENDING THE FENCE SIXTEEN (16) FEET FROM THE HOUSE (SIX (6) FEET FROM THE SIDEWALK), A PRIVACY FENCE (WITHOUT THE REQUIRED SPACE BETWEEN SLATS), AND NOT EXTENDING THE FENCE TO THE REAR PROPERTY LINE. THE SETBACK OF THE EXISTING HOUSE IS TWENTY-TWO (22) FEET RATHER THAN THE REQUIRED THIRTY (30) FEET OF THE CURRENT ORDINANCE. THE DRIVEWAY IS AT THE REAR OF THE PROPERTY WHICH IS THE REASON FOR NOT EXTENDING THE FENCE TO THE REAR PROPERTY LINE.

**RES 10-R11
FENCE VARIANCE
200 W. LINCOLN / NUDI**

THE BOARD DISCUSSED THE SETBACK REQUEST AND THE PRIVACY FENCE REQUEST. THE CONSENSUS WAS TO ALLOW THE FENCE TO EXTEND EIGHT (8) FEET FROM THE HOUSE, A SHADOWBOX TYPE OF FENCE, AND THE FENCE WOULD NOT HAVE TO EXTEND TO THE REAR PROPERTY LINE.

MOTION BY ECKMAN, SECONDED BY LIBERATORE, TO PASS RESOLUTION 10-R11 - A RESOLUTION REGARDING FENCE VARIANCE, 200 W. LINCOLN STREET. THE VARIANCE INCLUDES PLACEMENT OF THE FENCE EIGHT FEET FROM THE HOUSE, A SHADOWBOX TYPE OF FENCE, AND PLACEMENT WOULD NOT HAVE TO EXTEND TO THE REAR PROPERTY LINE. ECKMAN, LIBERATORE, REICHERT, RUSSELL, WICKER, AND FORSYTHE VOTING AYE; MOTION CARRIED.

THE DUMPSTER REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN DISCUSSED AT PREVIOUS MEETINGS. THE SCREENING REQUIREMENTS WILL BE REVIEWED ON A CASE BY CASE BASIS, DUMPSTERS SHALL HAVE A TIGHT FITTING LID AND THE NAME / NUMBER OF THE SCAVENGER SERVICE, A SCAVENGER LICENSE WILL BE \$50.00.

THE BOARD DISCUSSED CHANGES TO THE WATER BILLING PROCEDURE AT A PREVIOUS MEETING. THE CHANGES INCLUDE A TECHNICAL CORRECTION OF A TYPO AND A REFERENCE TO A CODE CITE, ELIMINATING THE SEPARATE MAILING OF THE SEVENTY-TWO HOUR NOTICE AND INCORPORATING THE NOTICE INTO THE SECOND BILLING NOTICE.
