CALL TO ORDER, ROLL CALL

THE POLICE COMMITTEE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 2:00 PM AT THE MUNICIPAL COMPLEX HALL, 208 E. MAIN STREET, PEOTONE, ILLINOIS, BY THE COMMITTEE CHAIR, TRUSTEE SLUIS. IN ATTENDANCE WERE TRUSTEE HUDSON AND TRUSTEE SLUIS. ALSO PRESENT WERE MAYOR MARCH, VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR, AIMEE INGALLS AND POLICE CHIEF, DAVID DEMIK.

DISCUSSION ON NONHIGHWAY VEHICLE (NHV) ORDINANCE

THE POLICE CHIEF AND TRUSTEE SLUIS HAVE REVIEWED THE CURRENT ORDINANCE AND HAVE UPDATED IT FOLLOWING STATE STATUTES. THE CURRENT ORDINANCE HAS NOT BEEN BEING ENFORCED BUT FOLLOWING APPROVAL OF THE REVISED ORDINANCE WARNINGS WILL INITIALLY BE GIVEN PRIOR TO ISSUING VIOLATIONS. THE REVISED ORDINANCE WILL INCLUDE THE DEFINITIONS OF DIFFERENT TYPES OF NON-HIGHWAY VEHICLES AND WILL INCLUDE EXAMPLES AND PICTURES. TWO WHEEL MOTORCYCLES AND FOUR WHEEL ATV'S WILL NOT BE INCLUDED AS ACCEPTABLE VEHICLES. REGISTRATION WILL BE REQUIRED AND WILL INCLUDE A VEHICLE SAFETY INSPECTION. STATE LAWS REQUIRE SEAT BELTS TO BE INSTALLED AND WORN, A VALID DRIVERS LICENSE AND LIABILITY INSURANCE COVERAGE. ALL OFFICERS WILL BE TRAINED TO CONDUCT INSPECTIONS AND A STICKER WILL BE ASSIGNED AFTER APPROVAL, THE YEARLY COST WILL BE \$10.00. REVISED ORDINANCE WILL BE PRESENTED FOR APPROVAL TO THE BOARD IN MAY.

REVIEW AND DISCUSSION OF POLICE OFFICER CANDIDATE

POLICE CANDIDATE, DANIEL NAPOLI, HAS BEEN SENT FOR A POLYGRAPH, PSYCHOLOGICAL EXAM AND PHYSICAL TEST. POLICE ACADEMY STARTS ON APRIL 22, 2024. WILL BE ON BOARD AGENDA FOR APPROVAL ON APRIL 8, 2024. IN APPROVED BUDGET AND WILL PROVIDE ADDITIONAL COVERAGE TO ALEVIATE SOME OVERTIME. THE POLICE ACADEMY IS FOURTEEN WEEKS LONG AND FIELD TRAINING IS APPROXIMATELY TWELVE WEEKS LONG.

GENERAL DISCUSSION

SERGEANT EXAM IS BEING HELD ON APRIL 6, 2024; FOUR OFFICERS WILL BE TAKING. WOULD FUNCTION AS SECONDARY PERSON AND THERE WILL BE SOME STRUCTURAL CHANGES IN THE DEPARTMENT IN THE FUTURE. THE ADMINISTRATOR REPORTED THAT OFFICERS HAD ASSISTED A WOMAN AND HER SON IN GETTING KEYS OUT OF THEIR CAR AND PRESENTED TO THE DEPARTMENT A CARD AND BASKET OF SNACKS IN APPRECIATION.
