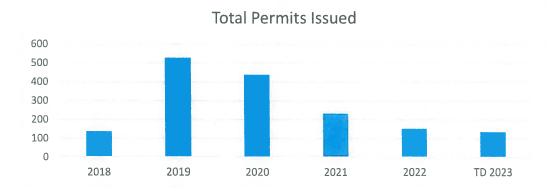
Our liability insurance renewal process is starting. We anticipate a 13-15% rate increase.
