Police and Public Safety Committee Meeting Minutes Decemeber 15th, 2021

Call to Order: The committee meeting was called to order at 5pm by Chairman Hudson , also in attendance were Trustee Marevka, Trustee Bowden, Chief Mort and resident Jim Fox

Approval of Minutes of July 8th, 2021: Motion by Marevka with second by Bowden to approve the minutes of July 8th meeting, Approved by a voice vote.

Resident concern: Resident Jim Fox reviewed with the committee the speed radar data from Sept1-Dec 1, 2021. Mr. Fox pointed out that 80% of the vehicles approaching and 60% driving past the sign are travelling below 25 mph. Mr. Fox is not in favor of stop signs being placed on Rathje road and wants more police presence. Chief Mort that there are some vehicles which speed on the road but manpower does not allow the police to be stationed there on continuing basis. The data shows that 94% of the vehicles approaching and 83% driving past the sign below 30mph.

Police Reform: Chief Mort advised that the department will begin the implementation of the reforms involving police training at the start of the new year.
