RULES PERTAINING TO SOLICITATION / CANVASSING / VENDOR

License / Permit may be revoked for violation of the following

- 1. Permitted hours: 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. NO SOLICITING ON SUNDAY
- 2. No person shall engage in, operate, or conduct the business of a solicitor, canvasser, peddler, itinerant merchant, or transient vendor in the village without first obtaining a license/permit. Each license/permit will be valid for the period of THREE CONSECUTIVE DAYS. NO SOLICITING ON SUNDAYS
- 3. A non-refundable fee of \$50.00 for the first person licensed and \$35.00 for each additional person licensed shall be paid to the Village Clerk at the time of license/permit application.
- 4. Each approved applicant shall be issued and shall wear at all times a Solicitor/Canvasser permit identification card. No solicitor, canvasser, vendor, or merchant shall allow the permit identification card to be worn or used by any person other than the person to whom it was issued.
- 5. No person shall call upon the occupants of any residence for the purpose of soliciting or canvassing, or for the purpose of making an appointment to solicit or canvass, if there is prominently posted and displayed at the entrance to such residence a notice containing a statement such as "Solicitors Prohibited", "No Soliciting", "No Canvassing", or the like.
- 6. Persons granted permits shall not make a nuisance of themselves with any citizen or resident of the village in attempting to obtain orders or subscriptions for their merchandise or publications.
- 7. There shall be no fraud, misrepresentation, or false statements contained on the application for the license/permit.
- 8. There shall be no fraud, misrepresentation, or false statement made as to the character, quality, or nature of his wares either for the purpose of obtaining license/permit or for the purpose of inducing a purchase in the course of carrying on the business as a solicitor or peddler.
- 9. There shall be no activity which could cause a conviction of the licensee or permit holder of any crime or misdemeanor involving moral turpitude.
- 10. There shall be no conducting the business of soliciting or peddling in an unlawful manner or in such a manner as to constitute a breach of the peace or to constitute a menace to the health, safety, or general welfare of the public.
- 11. No licensee or permit holder shall cry his wares upon the street nor shall he employ any device for the emanation of sound to attract attention to his wares upon the streets of the village.
- 12. No peddler/solicitor shall have any exclusive right to any location on a public street; nor shall any peddler/solicitor be permitted a stationary location; nor shall he/she be permitted to operate in any congested area where his/her operations might impede or inconvenience the public.
